TimeTrax Debuts New XM Stream Ripper

The company that earlier this year launched software to record XM Satellite Radio streams to computers by way of the XM PCR adapter — since discontinued — is back, with TimeTrax Connect. The new package, according to TimeTrax, records XM streams to PC by way of the satcaster's XM Direct in-car tuner and a USB adapter. The original TimeTrax allowed recorded streams to be split into individual digital song files, and the new version seems to do the same thing: The company says users can "store the files by artist and title for easy sorting," and those files can then be "accessed by PC, saved to a CD or uploaded onto an MP3 player." An XM representative didn't respond to a request for comment by press time.
